Recruitment of Meritorious Sports Persons

The Karnataka Forest Department invites applications from the eligible meritorious sports person for the posts of Deputy Range Forest Officers, Forest Guards and Forest Watchers in various Circles / Divisions of Karnataka. The selections of the candidates are made by the Special Recruitment Committee under the recruitment of meritorious sports persons in the manner specified under Karnataka Forest Department Services (Recruitment of Meritorious Sports persons in the category of Deputy Range Forest Officers, Forest Guards and Forest Watchers) (Special) Rules, 2015.

Mode of submission of Application:- On-Line Application Format, Notification will be published in the official website: www.aranya.gov.in. Candidates should submit their Application through On-line. Instructions to submit the Application will be displayed in the Website. The Candidates shall apply only one application for one post. Candidates should keep a copy of the Application with him/her.

Application Fee (through online):- For the Candidates belonging to General Merit, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB, the Application fee is Rs.100/- + Service Charge Rs.12/-. For the Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Category-I, the Application fee is Rs.50/- + Service Charge Rs.12/-. F. Written Examination: i) The candidates ranked in the ratio of 1:5 against each sports / games will be subjected to the written Aptitude test in respect of the Deputy Range Forest Officers. The Aptitude Test (Objective type) of the standard of Bachelor of Science Degree including B.Sc. Forestry. The Aptitude test is conducted with a maximum 100 marks for a period of 2 hours. The minimum qualifying marks is 40. All Tests will be conducted at

Bangalore. (Document Verification, Physical Standard Test, Physical Endurance Test, Physical Efficiency Test, Written Test, and Medical Tests conducted at Bangalore)

ii) In respect of Forest Guard and Forest Watcher they shall be no written Aptitude test. The marks obtained in 2nd PUC or SSLC as the case may be shall be the respective qualifying criteria.

iii) No candidates shall qualify for the selection to the posts specified under item No.1 unless they qualify in a test in Kannada language carrying a maximum of 150 marks and secure a minimum of 50 marks. Provided that the candidates are exempted from the Kannada language test if the candidate has passed the SSLC examination or its equivalent exam higher than SSLC in which Kannada is the main language or Second language or an optional subject (but not one of the subject in composite paper) or has passed in Kannada medium.

G. List of selected candidates: The Special Recruitment Committee prepares the final select list equal to the number of vacancies notified in Item No.2 E II (i) (ii) & (iii).

Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Forest Department Services (Recruitment of Meritorious Sports persons in the category of Deputy Range Forest Officers, Forest Guards and Forest Watchers) (special) Rules, 2015 was published as required by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. FEE 33 FEG 2015, dated 01-06-2015 in part IV-A of the Karnataka gazette dated: 01-06-2015 inviting objections and suggestions from all the persons likely to be affected thereby within 15 days from the date of its publication in the official gazette.

And whereas the said gazette was made available the public on 01-06-2015 and whereas no objections received within the period specified above.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

RULES

1. Title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Forest Department Services (Recruitment of Meritorious Sports persons in the category of Deputy Range Forest Officers, Forest Guards and Forest Watchers) (Special) Rules, 2015.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 or in the Karnataka Forest Department Services (Recruitment) Rules 2003, or any other rules of recruitment relating to the category of posts specified in the Schedule made or deemed to have been made under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990), the provision of these rules, shall apply to direct recruitment of 50 posts of Deputy Range Forest Officers, 50 posts of Forest Guards and 25 posts of Forest Watchers in the Karnataka Department of Forest Department Services as specified in the Schedule:

Provided that, nothing in these rules shall apply to more than one recruitment.

- 2. Definitions.-** (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-
- "Appointing Authority" means in case of Deputy Range Forest Officer the Chief Conservator of Forests concerned and in case of Forest Guard and Forest Watcher the Deputy Conservator of Forest concerned, Karnataka Forest Department.
 - "Special Recruitment Committee" means a special recruitment committee constituted under rule 3.
 - "Vacancies" means the vacant posts to be filled up in different category of posts as specified in column (2) of the schedule.
 - "Qualifying Examination" means the minimum qualification for the recruitment specified in column (4) of the schedule in respect of the posts specified in column(2) thereof.
 - "Schedule" means schedule appended to these rules.

(2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning assigned to it in the Karnataka Forest Department (Recruitment) Rules, 2003 and the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977, as amended from time to time.

3. Special Recruitment Committee.- (1) For the purpose of recruitment to the posts specified in the schedule there shall be a special recruitment committee, with the following members, namely:-

(2) Posts unfilled under these rules shall be filled by direct recruitment under regular rules of recruitment.

4. Method of Recruitment.- The selection of candidates under these rules shall be made by the Special Recruitment Committee in the manner specified below, namely:-

(1) **Calling for Application.-** The Special Recruitment Committee shall advertise the category of posts and the number of vacancies to be filled under these rules in the Official Gazette specifying the qualifying examination, age, the nature of selection, the classification of posts in accordance with the reservations policy provided by or under any law or order for the time being in force and invite applications from the intending candidates. Abstract of such advertisement shall also be published at least in two leading newspapers having wide circulation in the State, of which one shall be in Kannada.

(2) **Inviting for Physical Standard Test.-** After the receipt of the applications from the eligible candidates, the Special Recruitment Committee shall invite the candidates for physical standard test as specified below, every candidate shall,-

- (c) The guidelines for the special recruitment committee for preparing rank list of the applicants against each game / sports in a ratio of 1:5 based on the order of participation and performance of the sports / games are as follows, namely:-
- (i) The order, performance and the year of performance of the applicants obtained medals and certificates in their respective disciplines of sports / games as specified in clause (b) has to be considered for deciding the rank of the meritorious sports persons.
 - (ii) The individual event of the meritorious person is preferred over the team event and is subject to the vacancies proposed against each Sports / Games.
 - (iii) A maximum of 5 posts shall be considered for individual events and a maximum of 7 posts for group events against each category of posts.
 - (iv) The achievement in sports or games shall be in the immediate previous four years from the date of advertisement and the applicant shall be an active player. For this purpose previous four financial years from the date of receipt of the application or date of notification as the case may be shall be taken into account.

For example;

The applications received in 2014-15 (i.e., from 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2015 for recruitment through Notification issued through Open Advertisement, the sports achievements of current and previous four financial year i.e., 2010-11 onwards shall be taken into account and therefore, sports achievement on or after 01.04.2010 shall only be considered for appointment.

Concluding day of the Championship shall be taken into account for the purposes of reckoning the date of the championship.

- (v) The Original Certificates of achievements as specified in clause (b) shall be produced by the candidate as per the procedure notified by the recruitment authority calling the applications.
- (vi) The Candidate appointed under these rules must represent the department for at least five years from the date of appointment.

(6) Written Examination.- (a) The candidates found fit in the sports or games and whose names are ranked in a ratio of 1:5 against each game / sports shall be considered for the next stage i.e., written aptitude test by the Special Recruitment Committee in respect of the Deputy Range Forest Officers. The written Aptitude test (objective type) of the standard of Bachelor of Science Degree including B.Sc., (Forestry) shall be conducted for the Deputy Range Forest Officer.

(b) In respect of Forest Guards and Forest Watchers there shall be no written test. The marks obtained in Second PUC or SSLC as the case may be shall be the criteria for preparation of merit list. The Recruitment Authority after considering marks secured in the written test or the qualifying examination shall announce the merit list of the candidates.

5. List of selected Candidates.- (1) Special Recruitment Committee shall prepare final select list equal to the number of vacancies notified based on the merit list of candidates for each category of posts taking into consideration the orders, rules or any law in force relating to reservation of posts, vertical or horizontal, for the persons belonging to various categories based on the marks secured in the written examination or the qualifying examination as the case may be.

(2) If two or more candidates have secured equal level in the merit list prepared under rule 5, the order of merit in respect of such candidates shall be fixed on the basis of their age, the one older in age being placed higher in the order of merit. The number of candidates to be included in such list of eligible candidates shall be equal to the total number of vacancies specified in the schedule.

6. Additional List.-(1) The Special Recruitment Committee shall also prepare an additional list of such of the candidates not included in the list prepared under rule 5. The number of candidates to be included in such list shall, as far as possible be fifty percent of the number of vacancies specified in the schedule. There shall be at least one candidate in the additional list belonging to each of the reservation category (Horizontal and Vertical) represented in the list under rule 5. If the candidate whose name is included in the list under rule 5, fails to report for duty within the prescribed period, to the extent a candidate belonging to same reservation category shall be appointed as of the candidate who failed to report for duty shall be appointed from the additional list.

(2) The list prepared under rule 5 shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall be valid till all the vacancies specified under these rules are filled up or until the expiry of a period of one year from the date of publication of the list prepared under this rule and a copy there of shall be sent to the Appointing Authority.

7. Knowledge of Kannada language.- No candidates shall qualify for selection to posts specified in the Schedule unless he qualifies in a test in Kannada language comprising of paper carrying maximum of 150 marks and secures minimum of 50 marks in the said qualifying test.

Provided that, the Special Recruitment Committee may exempt a candidate from passing the Kannada language test if the candidate has passed the SSLC examination or any equivalent examination higher than SSLC in which Kannada in the main language or second language or an optional subject (but not one of the subject in composite paper) or has passed in Kannada medium.

8. Police Verification.-A Police verification report shall be obtained through the concerned District Police Authority about the antecedents of the candidates in the Final Select List.

9. Indemnity Bond.- On appointment as Deputy Range Forest Officer, Forest Guard as the case may be, every candidate shall execute an indemnity bond with two sureties to the satisfaction of the Appointing Authority that he shall serve the department for a period of not less than five years, failing which the cost of twelve or six months training course as the case may be shall be reimbursed to the Government.

10. Training.- If the candidate fails to complete the training course successfully within the period specified he shall be given one more chance to complete the training, at the cost of the candidate. If he is unable to complete the training successfully in second chance he shall be liable to be discharged from service and the training cost shall be recovered from him as per the bond so executed. If the candidate fails to complete the probationary period satisfactorily he shall be discharged from the service by recovering training cost from him as per the indemnity bond so executed.

11. Determination of seniority.- Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 5 of the Karnataka Government Servant (Seniority) Rules, 1957, the inter-se seniority among the candidates selected in the above selection shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the training in respect of Deputy Range Forest Officers and Forest Guards. In respect of Forest Watchers the inter-se seniority is as per the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

12. Appointment of Candidates.- (1) Candidates whose names are included in the final select list prepared under rule 5 may be appointed by the appointing authority in the vacancies in the order in which their names are found in the list after satisfying itself after such enquiry as it may consider necessary that each of the candidates is suitable in all respects for appointment.

(2) The inclusion of name of a candidate in the list published under rule 5 shall not confer any right of appointment.

13.
