**ADVERTISEMENT**

Applications are invited from the desirous candidates having requisite qualification and experience along with supporting documents as required under Rule-6 of the Family Courts (Orissa) Rules, 1990 and Family Courts (Orissa) Amendment Rule, 1994 as per the Resolution No.3514(6), dated 27.03.2017 of the Hon'ble High Court for filling up of the vacant post of Principal Counsellor and Counsellor in the Court of the Judge, Family Court, Bargarh. The Principal Counsellor and Counsellor shall be appointed by the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa.

**1. ELIGIBILITY & QUALIFICATIONS OF COUNSELLOR:**

- (a) Be a citizen of India
- (b) Have passed Master's Degree in (Social Science preferably in Sociology or Psychology).
- (c) Have minimum experience of 3 years in family counseling shall be eligible for appointment as Counsellors:
- (d) Be able to speak, read and write Odia and have passed test in Odia equivalent to the M.E standard.
- (e) Be of sound health, good physique and free from organic defects or bodily infirmity and
- (f) Have not more than one spouse living.

Provided that where such persons are not available, persons above the age of thirty-five working in the field of social service and welfare activities and engaged in promoting the welfare Family and Child Care with a degree in (Social Science preferably in Sociology or Psychology) shall be eligible for such appointment.

**2. FUNCTIONS OF A COUNSELLOR:**

The function of Counsellors shall be regulated in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the Family Courts (Orissa) Rules, 1990 and amendment made there under from time to time.

**3. FEE OF A COUNSELLOR:**

As per Rule-33 of the Family Courts (Orissa) Rules, 1990, the Principal Counsellor and the Counsellor shall be entitled to assisting fee of Rs.750/- (seven hundred fifty) and Rs.525/- (five hundred twenty five) only respectively as per day of actual work.

**4. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:**

- (i) Self attested Xerox copies of all Educational qualification certificates.
- (ii) Experience certificate in the field of social service and welfare activities and engaged in promoting the welfare of Family and Child Care with a degree in (Social Science preferably in Sociology or Psychology) shall be eligible for such appointment:
- (iii) Self attested two number of Passport size photographs.

**5. HOW TO APPLY:**

Applications with required documents be sent by Registered Post/ Speed Post or can be submitted in the office of the undersigned during the office hour on or before the date fixed.

**6. WHEN TO APPLY:**

The last date of receipt of applications is 01.05.2017. Applications received thereafter shall not be considered.
